EASTERN WARDENS TO MEET WITH DAVID MILLER

Belleville: The Eastern Ontario Wardens' Caucus and Toronto Mayor David Miller will be meeting in Belleville on Friday, September 21, to discuss matters of mutual interest, caucus chair Doug Struthers announced today.

“Our meeting is an opportunity for the Wardens' Caucus and Mayor Miller to sit down together and discuss a wide range of issues that face both the City and the local governments we represent across Eastern Ontario,” said Struthers. “Mayor Miller has been a very effective advocate for change in local government, particularly on the issue of financial sustainability,” added Hastings County Warden Terry Clemens.

“The challenges facing Eastern Ontario counties and municipalities and the City of Toronto are very much the same,” Mayor Miller said. “We all require sustainable and permanent funding from the provincial and federal governments – including the equivalent of one cent of the GST – to meet the infrastructure and social needs of our communities. I look forward to meeting with the Wardens' Caucus in order to exchange and share ideas.”

The meeting will be held in Belleville in the Park Room at the Ramada Inn commencing at 9:00 a.m. Members of the media are welcome to attend.
